What to Bring to Camp

- 2 towels
- 3 pairs of shorts
- 3 pairs of socks
- 3 t-shirts
- 5 pairs of underwear
- 1 pair of shoes
- 1 pair of sandals
- 2 swim suits
- 1 pillow
- 1 pair of jeans
- 1 set of church clothes
- 1 can of SPF30 sunscreen
- 1 blanket
- 1 set of bed sheets (twin)/Sleeping bag
- hat(s)
- toiletries

Campers may bring fishing gear, ski equipment, skateboard, rip stick, tennis racket, helmet, and knee/elbow pads. In order to participate in skateboarding/rip sticking campers must wear appropriate safety equipment (helmet and knee/elbow pads).

What NOT to Bring to Camp

- cell phone
- body piercing jewelry
- desk lamp
- laser pointer
- computer
- electronics (i.e. TV, radios, iPods, etc.)
- alarm clock
- 2-way radios
- music with inappropriate language
- scooters

NOT ALLOWED at Camp

- Alcohol
- Illegal drugs
- Guns/weapons
- Tobacco
- Knives
- Fireworks
- Pornography
- Cigarettes
